All Belt Promotion Testing



It's time for Rank (belt) Advancement testing. Testing will be held on Saturday, Mach 19<sup>th</sup> for all belts. White/Yellow/Orange belts testing will start at 9am. Green/Blue/Purple belts testing will start at 9:45 am. Brown/High Brown/Red belt testing will begin at 10:30 am. High Red and Black Belts credit testing will start at 11:00 am. Please remember your current belt rank which is the testing time that you will attend. Grand Master Park and Instructors will award stripes to those students who have displayed the skills and endurance for their current rank. Students who have received all 4 stripes are ready for testing. All testing will take place at the Clarkson/Clayton location. Testing students should wear full uniforms at testing day.

# PARK'S MARTIAL ARTS 19<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL TAE KWON DO CHAMPIONSHIP



On April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016, Park's Martial Arts will host the 19th Annual Open Tae Kwon Do Championship, which is held at Lafayette High School. The competition is open to all students with the rank of White Belt through Black Belt. All 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners from each division will receive a beautiful trophy. This tournament will help promote the spirit of the Martial Arts, and will renew students' enthusiasm for the arts. We hope students feel an even greater love for the arts after they attend. There are four events in which you

may compete in: Forms, sparring, and board breaking, and family forms. **Before April 15**<sup>th</sup>, the cost is \$65.00 for one/two event, \$75 for three events, and \$85 for four events. **After April 15**<sup>th</sup>, the cost is \$75 for one/two event, \$85 for three events, and \$95 for four events. Boards must be purchased at the tournament for a small fee. Please return the entry form as soon as possible so that Grand Master Park and our Instructors can help students perfect their form and practice for breaking. Remember, there is sparring class at Clarkson every Wednesday at 7:00 PM. We hope to see you all at the tournament.

In the month of March & April, you can purchase practice boards @ Park's. Please bring in your purchased board to class, so that the Instructors can help you practice your breaking techniques. Adult board is \$2, children board is \$1.50 each.

### **Black Belt Dan Promotion Testing**
