On May 13th, 2017 Park's Martial Arts will be hosting the 20th annual Tae Kwon Do Open Champion**ship**. The tournament will be held at Lafayette High School. It is open to all students with the rank of White Belt through Black Belt. All 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners from each division will receive beautiful medals to display at home. There are four events in which you may compete: Forms, Sparring, Family Form, and Board Breaking. The cost is \$55 for one ,\$65 for two events, \$75 for three events, \$85 for four events before April 29th (pre-registration), and after the deadline \$65 for one event, \$75 for two events, \$85 for three events, \$95 for four events.
