## **Black Belt Dan Testing**



Our next opportunity for Black Belt Dan Testing will be <u>Saturday, April</u>

**<u>27<sup>th</sup> at 9am</u>**. Testing forms and packets for Black Belt Dan Testing are now available at both schools. If you plan to test, make sure to start your preparations early to ensure success!

Testing forms are due no later than <u>Saturday, March</u> <u>**16**<sup>th</sup></u> in order to ensure you receive your belt on testing day.

## **Black Belt Dan Testing Preparations**

Black Belt Dan Testing is a big commitment and requires quite a bit of preparation. In order to make sure all our testing students are ready to put their best foot forward at Dan Testing in April, each student will be required to attend several special training events.

#### **Black Belt Boot Camp**

Black Belt Boot Camp is required for ALL April Dan Testing students. Boot Camp will be held at Bluebird Park on <u>Saturday, March 30<sup>th</sup> at 9am</u>. Black Belt Boot Camp lasts approximately one (1) hour. For students needing a ride to and from Bluebird Park, you can meet at the Clarkson Clayton school no later than 8:45am.

#### **Black Belt Prep Class**

Black Belt Prep Class is an important part of preparing for Dan Testing. Prep Class will be held at the Clarkson Clayton school on <u>Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup> at 12pm</u>. Black Belt Prep Class lasts approximately one (1) hour. Black Belt Prep Class is not required but is highly recommended for all Dan Testing students.

#### **Sunday Sessions**

In addition to Boot Camp and Prep Class, each testing student will be required to attend several Sunday Sessions led by Grandmaster Park. These sessions will run from 11am-12:30pm at the Clarkson Clayton school. *Please choose at least three (3) of the five (5) available sessions to attend.* If you do not attend the required number of Sunday Sessions, you will not be allowed to test on April 27, 2019.

#### **Rehearsal Testing**

All Dan Testing student are required to attend Rehearsal Testing on Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup> at the Clarkson Clayton school. Rehearsal Testing will begin at 7pm and runs for approximately one (1) hour.

## 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Park's Open Tae Kwon Do Championship



On Saturday, May 11, 2019, Park's Martial Arts will be hosting our **22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Open Tae Kwon Do Championship**. This tournament will be held at Lafayette High School. It is

open to all students from White to Black Belt. Competition events are: Official Form, Board Breaking, Sparring, Weapon, and Family Form. 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in each division will receive medals. 1<sup>st</sup> place Black Belt finishers will have the opportunity to compete for Grand Champion in Official Form and Board Breaking. The cost during pre-registration is \$65 for one (1) or two events (2), with an additional \$10 fee for each added event. After the pre-registration deadline of April 27<sup>th</sup>, the price increases to \$75 for one (1) or two (2) events, with an additional \$10 for each added event. Boards for the breaking competition must be purchased at the tournament venue for an additional charge. All students are encouraged to participate in this tournament.
