ALL BELT PROMOTION TESTING



Once again it is time for our students to advance in rank. Testing will be held on <u>Saturday, April 13th</u> at the Clarkson Clayton school.

9am- White, Yellow & Orange Belts

9:45am - Green, Blue & Purple Belts

10:30am - Brown, High Brown, Red & High Red Belts

11:15am – All Black Belt Credit Testing

Grand Master Park and the Instructors will award stripes to those students who have displayed the skills and endurance for their current rank. Testing forms must be filled out and returned no later than <u>Wednesday, April 10th</u> in order to receive your belt on testing day. The Belt Ceremony will take place immediately after testing.

Black Belt Dan Testing will be <u>Saturday, April 27th at</u> <u>9am</u>. Dan Testing will take place at Parkway Southwest Middle School, beginning at 9am.

Parkway Southwest Middle School is located at 701 Wren Ave, Ballwin, MO 63021.

Testing Forms for Dan Testing were due March 16th. No additional Testing Forms will be accepted for Dan Testing.

Due to Black Belt Dan Testing, there will be no regularly scheduled classes on Saturday, April 27th.

Black Belt Boot Camp

Boot Camp has been rescheduled to Saturday, April 6th at 9am. Boot Camp is held at Bluebird Park, and is mandatory for all Dan Testing students.

Black Belt Prep Class

Black Belt Prep Class is an important part of preparing for Dan Testing. Prep Class will be held at the Clarkson Clayton school on Saturday, April 20th at 12pm. Black Belt Prep Class lasts approximately one (1) hour. Black Belt Prep Class is not required but is highly recommended for all Dan Testing students.

Sunday Sessions

In addition to Boot Camp and Prep Class, each testing student will be required to attend several Sunday Sessions led by Grandmaster Park. These sessions will run from 11am-12:30pm at the Clarkson Clayton school. Please choose at least three (3) of the five (5) available sessions to attend. If you do not attend the required number of Sunday Sessions, you will not be allowed to test on April 27, 2019.

Rehearsal Testing

All Dan Testing student are required to attend Rehearsal Testing on Friday, April 26th at the Clarkson Clayton school. Rehearsal Testing will begin at 7pm and runs for approximately one (1) hour.

22nd Annual Park's Open Tae Kwon **Do Championship**



On Saturday, May 11, 2019, Park's Martial Arts will be hosting our 22nd Annual Open Tae Kwon Do Championship. This tournament will be held at Lafayette High School. It is

open to all students from White to Black Belt. Competition events are: Official Form, Board Breaking, Sparring, Weapon, and Family Form. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each division will receive medals. 1st place Black Belt finishers will have the opportunity to compete for Grand Champion in Official Form and Board Breaking. The cost during pre-registration is \$65 for one (1) or two events (2), with an additional \$10 fee for each added event. After the pre-registration deadline of April 27th, the price increases to \$75 for one (1) or two (2) events, with an additional \$10 for each added event. Boards for the breaking competition must be purchased at the tournament venue for an additional charge. All students are encouraged to participate in this tournament.
