22nd Annual Park's Open Tae Kwon Do Championship



On <u>Saturday, May 11, 2019</u>, Park's Martial Arts will be hosting our 22nd Annual Open Tae Kwon Do Championship. This tournament will be held at Lafayette High School. It is

open to all students from White to Black Belt. Competition events are: Official Form, Board Breaking, Sparring, Weapon, and Family Form. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each division will receive medals. 1st place Black Belt finishers will have the opportunity to compete for Grand Champion in Official Form and Board Breaking.

Pre-registration has closed. The price of registration is \$75 for one (1) or two (2) events, with an additional \$10 for each added event. Boards for the breaking competition must be purchased at the tournament venue for an additional charge. All students are encouraged to participate in this tournament.
